

Workshop on facilitating Digital Negotiations with Geodesignhub

As cities continue to grow and new urban mobility practices emerge, the design of streets often no longer fit with the citizens' demand of high-quality public spaces. This has a direct impact on the experience of the way people use the street.

The temporary closure of a main street in Santiago de Chile was taken as an opportunity to rethink the way it operated and propose tactical interventions focused on wellbeing and development of new pedestrian experiences. However, how do you choose what set of interventions work the best? Any interventions that are implemented need a negotiation with the different stakeholders. How do you enable such negotiations?

In this workshop you will learn how digital negotiations can develop a consensus when it comes to making decisions. These negotiations can be undertaken in short online or in-person meetings and you will participate in a online meeting to negotiate develop a way forward for the street.
